1. Supply of semi submersible drilling rig "Lone Star" completed

The semi submersible drilling rig "Lone Star" has been delivered and handed over to our client Queiroz Galvão Perfurações S.A. offshore Abu Dhabi on 13 October 2010.

The rig is the first out of a series of three semi submersible drilling rigs which the Company will supply to Brazilian clients. Delivery of the second and third rigs is progressing in line with previous announcements, i.e. the second rig is expected to be delivered later this year and the third rig in 2011.
